## **AI Policy Statement**

OMG STUDIOS/ KZMOHD affirms that music, art, and cultural expression are essential to human survival, development, and collective well-being. Any use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) by KZMOHD must strengthen cultural sustainability, deepen community connection, and improve the health and wellness of youth and families in under-invested communities.

AI is a support tool—not a decision-maker, creator, or cultural authority.

# Guiding Principles

**1. Human Survival & Wellness First** – AI must enhance emotional, cultural, and communal health.

**2. Cultural Sovereignty** – Community retains ownership of stories, data, and creative work.

**3. Consent-Based Use** – Voices, images, and cultural materials are used only with informed consent.

**4. Human-in-the-Loop** – Cultural interpretation and publishing require human oversight.

**5. Economic Dignity** – AI use must create paid opportunities for artists, youth, and culture bearers.

**6. Transparency & Accountability** – AI tools and impacts are publicly reviewed.

# Governance

Participants will work in cohorts to innovate governance around cultural AI by . . .

- Establishing a **Community AI Council** (elders, youth, artists, technologists).
- Conduct an AI ethics and impact review.
- Innovate a Cultural Artificial Intelligence system involving cultural data.

## Prohibited Uses

- Automated cultural interpretation or publishing
- Sale or transfer of community data or IP
- Black-box AI systems without transparency

# OMG STUDIOS / KZMOHD's APPROACH

OMG STUDIOS/KZMOHD's approach to Artificial Intelligence is grounded in cultural sustainability and love for humanity. We recognize music and art as essential infrastructure for human survival, identity formation, and community health. Rather than using AI for efficiency or scale alone, KZMOHD deploys technology as a tool to preserve cultural memory, empower youth voice, and strengthen economic pathways for artists and families in under-invested communities.

Through consent-based AI systems, KZMOHD preserves oral histories, music archives, and community storytelling while ensuring that elders and culture bearers remain the primary interpreters of meaning. Youth engage AI as a creative and civic tool—learning how narratives are shaped and reclaiming authorship over their own stories. All AI-supported programming integrates wellness, creative expression, and intergenerational exchange.

This initiative positions KZMOHD as a national model for ethically grounded, community-governed AI that strengthens cultural continuity while generating sustainable economic opportunities for local creators.

# OMG STUDIOS / KZMOHD's APPROACH

## **Innovation Lab 2026 Core Activities**

1. Art Project Course Instruction
2. Record and archive 25–30 oral histories (artists, elders, community leaders)
2. Launch youth AI + music/storytelling labs (ages 14–19)
3. Develop AI-assisted archive system (transcription, tagging, access)
4. Produce community media content from archives
5. Establish Community AI Council and review process
6. 50 research hours will be documented, including watching all six “Juneteenth Reckoning with Slavery” films as part of the project research.
