Reckoning with Truth Tour
Legacy Sites - Montgomery, AL
July 31 – August 3, 2026**

Day One: Friday, July 31, 2026

- MABL Pathway scholars and staff will arrive at Minneapolis / Saint Paul International airport to check in for a flight that departs at 7:00am to Montgomery, Alabama with a one hour and thirty-one (1:31) minute layover in Atlanta, GA on flight #DL1039. Everyone will change planes to Montgomery on flight #DL4955, leaving Atlanta at 12:03pm, arriving in Montgomery at 12:02pm.

- Ubers will shuttle everyone to Elevation Convening Hotel located at 600 Montgomery St., Montgomery, AL 36104 to check in. Check in is at 3:00pm.
- We will convene in the Freddie Gray room for lunch and a screening of Reconstruction Destructed featuring Bryan Stevenson and Duchess Harris screening 1:30pm – 3:00pm.
- Take a self-guided tour of [Montgomery Square](#) at 3:00pm.
- Relax or tour the beautiful Elevation Hotel until the welcome dinner at Elevation's [AYA Soulful Dining](#) from 6:30pm – 8:00pm.

Day Two: Saturday August 1, 2026

- Breakfast at AYA at 8:30am. At 9:30am, everyone will meet in the lobby to board the shuttle to EJI's Legacy museum where you will confront our nation's history of enslavement.
- Noon lunch at Panne George's located next to the Legacy Museum in the private dining room from 11:30pm – 12:30pm.

- Board shuttle at 12:30pm to take a short ride to the Legacy Peace and Justice Memorial.
- At 3:30pm, board shuttle or take a short walk to Elevation Hotel.
- Meet in lobby to go to Dreamland Barbeque for dinner at 6:30pm.
- Optional: After dinner walk in downtown Montgomery where history remembers the hundreds of enslaved persons who were chained and marched from slave cargo ships to slave auction houses that line the streets, and along the riverfront where the infamous “Alabama Brawl” occurred on August 5, 2023, reflecting on the wounds that run deep, confirming the need for all to reckon with the truth of our history of enslavement in America, before we can move forward in unity and respect for one another.
- For those who opt out of the riverfront walk, an Uber will take you to Elevation Convening Hotel.

Day Three: Sunday, August 2, 2026

- Breakfast at AYA at 9:00am
- Everyone will meet in the lobby at 10:00am to board the shuttle to the riverfront to cruise to Monument Sculpture Park.
- 12:00pm departure to Elevation hotel for lunch at AYA.
- Relaxation afternoon to enjoy yourself with the amenities at Elevation hotel: swimming, gym, sauna, library reading, meditation garden are a few recommendations. There are many historic sites in walking distance of the hotel.
- Buffet dinner / Legacy Sites reflection in hotel conference center.

Day Four: Monday, August 3, 2026

- Rosa Parks Museum Tour 10:00am - noon
- Lunch / Debrief 12noon – 1:00pm
- 1:00pm – 2:00pm Session with an EJI attorney at Elevation Convening Hotel (location TBD)
- Depart hotel at 4:00pm to Montgomery Airport to board flight to Minneapolis, MN, with a layover in Atlanta, arriving at MSP at 12:22am (shortly after midnight on Aug. 4th).
